

Summary of Teaching Experience

From Fall 2005 through Spring 2009, I taught part-time in the Philosophy Department at Hunter College of The City University of New York. For most of that time, I served as primary instructor for one or two courses per semester, plus one in the summer. I trained for my teaching role by serving as a teaching assistant during the 2005/06 and 2006/07 academic years. I have designed and taught four different courses: PHIL 244 Moral Philosophy, PHIL 250 Ethics & Society, PHIL 104 Introduction to Ethics, and PHIL 103 Introduction to Logic & Critical Thinking.
